

MEXICO TRIP PARTICIPANT CONTRACT

- Team members will comply with the “buddy system” at all times. No team member shall, at any time, venture away from the group without a buddy and without permission to be separated from the group.
- Team members are not to be off the camping site or the construction site without permission.
- Team members are to participate in scheduled work times, ministry events, team times, etc. and to be on time (unless previous permission has been granted by a trip leader to not be in attendance).
- No smoking, drinking alcoholic beverages or consuming non-medical drugs shall be allowed by a team member. Team members may not possess or acquire weapons or object that appear to be weapons or could be used as a weapon.
- Team member are to avoid swearing or crude jokes.
- Team members cannot engage in inappropriate physical contact with one another or the nationals; no intimate, exclusive, romantic relationships will be permitted.
- Team members are not to be in the tents of the opposite sex.
- Team members cannot take photos of nationals before asking their permission and cannot photograph security, military, police personnel or installations.
- Team members will be tolerant of the new culture and not openly complain or criticize differences. Courtesy and respect for other team members, Amor staff and the nationals is expected at all times.
- The Calvin Christian Collegiate Human Dignity Policy and other pertinent school rules, as detailed in the student agenda and elsewhere, are in full effect on the trip, just as they are at school.
- If there is non-compliance to the rules and expectations, or attitudes that are detrimental to the team, the leadership has the authority to send the team member home. I/we the undersigned, are the parent(s) having legal custody, or the legal guardian(s) of the above named participant, have given our consent for him/her to attend a mission trip operated by Calvin Christian Collegiate and Amor, or are of legal consenting age myself. I/we understand that a member of the staff or the lead adult of our group may need to send a participant home as a result of illness or discipline problem. I/we understand if the participant named above is dismissed from the mission trip, I/ he/ she will be transported home at my/our expense.
