At Calvin Christian School, we have always encouraged our students to volunteer with servant hearts. We believe that we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do (Ephesians 2:10). With this belief, we have asked that our students meet a goal of 110 service hours over the course of their high school education. At Graduation, students will receive 1 academic credit for their volunteer efforts over these four years. To note: if a student reaches this goal, and passes all of their high school Bible classes, they will also receive a special Calvin Christian School diploma at Graduation!

Items of interest:

- Service hours can accumulate from 1 place or a variety of places. This is different from past years where only a certain number of hours could come from, for example, teaching Sunday School. Now, all 110 hours could be from doing just that!
- Students will hand in their hours as they complete them. Forms are to be given to Mrs. Jeninga in the Academic Guidance Office.
- Students are asked to source their own service opportunities, however, the school does offer two significant ones that can be used towards their total:
 - Grade 11: Impact Trip to Mexico = 30 hours
 - Grade 12: Inner City Experience (I.C.E.) = 30 hours
