High School Humanities Teacher (English, History, and or Bible) Grades 9 to 12

Calvin Christian School is accepting applications for High School Humanities teaching positions for Grades 9 to 12, beginning in the 2026 to 2027 school year.

These positions will involve teaching courses in English, Social Studies/History, and/or Bible, depending on the qualifications, experience, and interests of the successful candidate, as well as the scheduling needs of the school. There may also be opportunity to teach other elective courses, depending on the gifts and interests of the successful candidate.

Two positions are available:

- One position at 0.80 to 1.00 FTE
- One position at approximately 0.50 to 0.65 FTE

The successful candidates will be passionate about helping students grow as thoughtful readers, writers, and critical thinkers while engaging literature, history, and biblical perspectives through a Christian worldview.

Primary Responsibilities

- Teach courses in English, Social Studies/History, and or Bible at the senior years level (Grades 9 to 12)
- Plan engaging lessons aligned with Manitoba curriculum outcomes
- Support the development of strong literacy, writing, and analytical skills
- Guide students in thoughtful discussion of historical events, literature, and biblical themes
- Teach Bible courses that explore the historical context of Scripture, including the story of God's people in the Old Testament, and examine the growth of the early church through the book of Acts and church history
- Help students explore themes such as God's faithfulness, the work of the Spirit, and God's invitation for His people to participate in His story
- Lead students in respectful dialogue and reflection as they examine worldviews and religions represented in our broader community
- Assess student learning and provide timely and meaningful feedback
- Foster a respectful and supportive classroom environment
- Collaborate with colleagues and contribute to the life of the school community

Qualifications

- Valid Manitoba Teaching Certification
- Teachable subject areas in English and/or History preferred
- Ability to teach Bible within a Christian worldview framework
- Experience teaching at the senior years level is an asset
- Commitment to Christian education and alignment with the school's foundational beliefs

Application Requirements

Interested applicants are asked to submit the following:

- Cover letter
- Resume
- Statement of faith, including the name of the church currently attended
- Philosophy of Christian education

All employees of Calvin Christian School must be eligible for Society membership. A membership interview forms part of the hiring process. Additional membership requirements, including a pastoral reference and agreement with the school's foundational beliefs, will be completed prior to hiring.
